



The Riviera Beach Marina Day Celebration will mark the commencement of the Riviera Beach Community Boating Program (CBP). The CBP was approved by the CRA Board of Commissioners in November, and is being provided by the Florida Fishing Academy. The CBP will provide access to water sports (kayaking, sailing, boating, fishing and other activities) and water amenities, as well as life skills to Riviera Beach youth ages 8-18 (students must be pre-enrolled and be Riviera Beach Residents). The first class was held January 7th. Instruction will be provided via weekly classes, and summer camps, while monthly community events (Marina Day Celebration) will serve to both advertise the CBP and promote the City's Marina and other water amenities to the greater community. The first annual Riviera Beach Marina Day Celebration will be held on February 18, 2012 from 10:00am-2:00pm at Bicentennial Park (300 E. 13th Street, Riviera Beach).

Planned activities for the program include water rescue demonstrations, tours of the Riviera Beach PD Police Boat (and other local agency vessels), free food, boat rides to Peanut Island, and other fun family friendly activities. Students must be pre-enrolled to attend the Community Boating Program, while the monthly Riviera Beach Marina Day celebrations are free and open to the entire community.
